## Program Schedule & Highlights

Chamber Music Connection's Adult Programs offer an opportunity for adult amateur musicians to study and play chamber music together. Each ensemble is arranged based on enrolled instrumentation and may include strings, winds, and/or keyboard. Music is provided and each ensemble meets for coaching and rehearsals with esteemed CMC associated faculty.

### Fall and Winter Semesters

**Fridays, Sept. 21 - Nov. 2, 2007, & Monday, Nov. 5 (concert)**

**Fridays, Jan. 18, - Feb. 29, 2008, & Monday, March 3 (concert)**

Fall and Winter Semesters each include consecutive Friday evening sessions, which coincide with CMC's general program for students of all ages, from **6:30 - 7:45 PM**. Final concerts are held in conjunction with the CMC jazz program.

### Spring Weekend with Cavani Quartet

**Friday, May 16 - Saturday, May 17, 2008**

Held at Ohio Wesleyan University, weekend includes coaching, Cavani concert, workshops with Cavani members, final concert.

### Summer Adult "Evenings of Chamber Music"

**Sunday, July 13 - Wednesday, July 16 • 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM**

The "Evenings of Chamber Music" is a program designed strictly for adult groups. Each evening consists of 2 sessions: one for rehearsal/reading time, and one for coaching. Informal sharing on last evening.

## Coordinator of Adult Programs

Dr. Emily Butterfield, a CMC Associate Faculty Member, is beginning her fourth year as CMC's Adult Program Coordinator. Also on the faculty of Muskingum College and Mt. Vernon Nazarene University, Dr. Butterfield, a flutist, performs in area chamber and large ensemble venues including the Favorable Winds and the Schulhoff Trio. In 2005 she was a featured soloist in CMC's Conservatory Concert Series.
